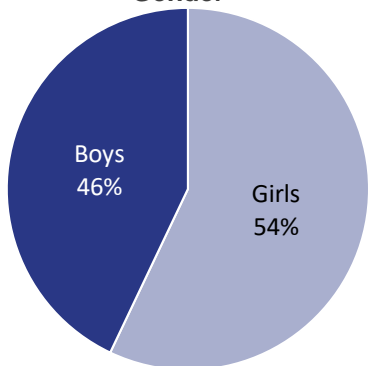

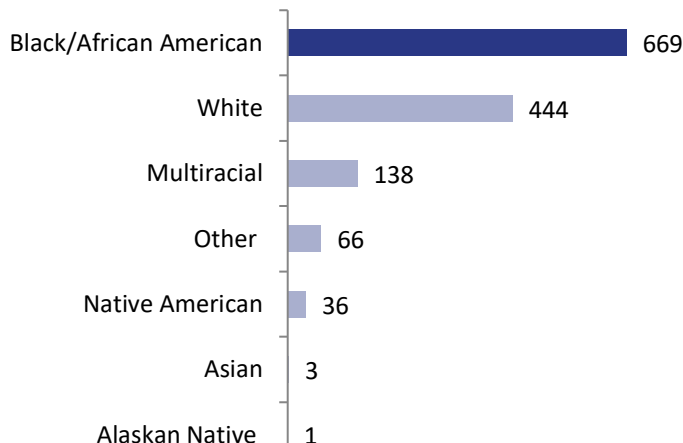

## Mentee Demographics

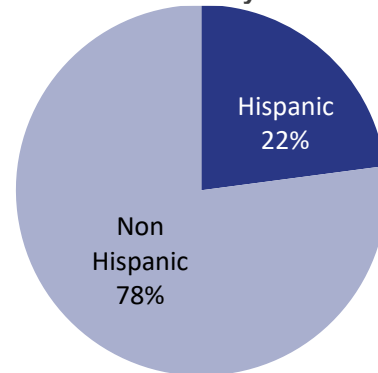
Gender



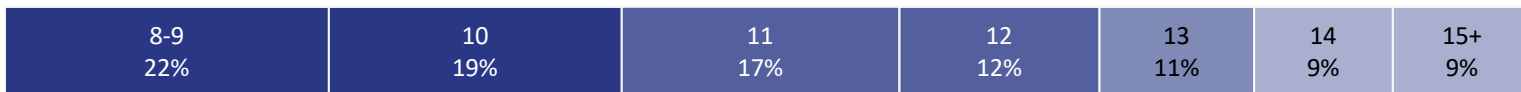
Race



Ethnicity

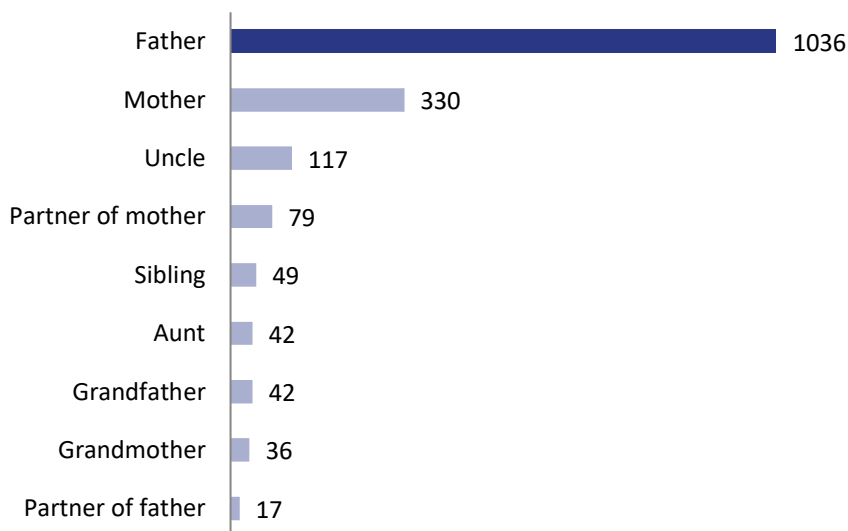


Age (in years)
